



First, find this symbolic mark. Looking at the map, you realize it is one of the installations found along the Way to the Hidden Garden.




Time to explore — walk the Way to the Hidden Garden yourself. Each mark matches an object along the path.





That means the Mysterious Fragment you're searching for is a triangular slice of pizza.





This sculpture is called Two Women.



Look closely — you'll see one woman sitting in front and the other behind her. Observe their features and clothing carefully:

The woman sitting in front is:




The woman sitting behind is:



Now, sort the details:

- Traits of the woman in front go into the blue circle.
- Traits of the woman behind go into the red circle.



When placed correctly, one item appears within the overlapping red-and-blue arc —the pants. That means the Mysterious Fragment you need to select is the one with a picture of pants on it.






In the photo, you can spot the following sculptures:

- · Dancing with the Wind
- A Guidepost Man with a Beast on His Shoulders
- (Dohyo) Crow
- · You're My Chair, I'm Yours
- Triangle
- Saikato

First, uncover the pattern in the equation for these sculptures.

3 Crows



1 Human

1 Beast

No animals

Although the photos are the same, the answers differ:

The top one equals 3, while the bottom one equals 4.

When you closely examine the sculptures in the photos, you'll notice they are shaped like both humans and/or animals.

Now, focus only on the humans and animals in the sculptures:

- Count the number of humans in the photos surrounded by a bule frame.
- Count the number of animals in the photos surrounded by an orange frame.

Add the numbers together using this formula. Looking at the photos below, count the humans (bule frame) and the animals (orange frame).



The total will give you the number 22.
This means the Mysterious Fragment you need to select is the one with the number 22 on it.






What does this diagram reveal? It illustrates the scale of size. The order of the animals by size is as follows: Elephant \rightarrow Deer \rightarrow Cat \rightarrow Mouse \rightarrow Ant

In the top part of the image, you'll find drawings of an elephant, an ant, a deer, a mouse, and a cat.


In the bottom part of the image, you'll see the following sculptures:






Now, visit the sculptures in person and observe their sizes. When you connect the correct lines, a diamond shape will emerge.


The Mysterious Fragment is hidden within the diamond.








"S \rightarrow G" represents the path from S (START) to G (GOAL). You begin at S, the sculpture Luette et Narines, and make your way toward G, the sculpture Way.






Along the route, you will pass several sculptures, as shown on the map below. Connect them in the order you encounter them to reveal the answer.



- S: Luette et Narines
- ① Inside the hole of Luette et Narines (Uvula and Nostrils)
- ② A section of 1•9•8•5 Intellectual Depression
- 3 The crow from (Dohyo) Crow
- 4 A section of Different Space
- (5) The jaw and hand of Invocation for Reclamation (Invocation II)
- **⑥** A section of My Sky Hole 85-7
- G: Way

When you connect the points, the lines form a trapezoid. That means the Mysterious Fragment you're looking for is the one shown here on the right.







What could this bomb-like mark represent?



Search for the sculpture on the map. Do you notice a similar pattern?












The Poem of Kotankuru-Kamui features 2 owls and 4 black birds, while (Dohyo) Crow shows 3 crows.

The common thread is birds.



The round shapes represent their heads, and the lines represent their beaks.

That means the Mysterious Fragment you're looking for is the beak.
